Our Curriculum

Children are set individual and realistic targets throughout the year and you will be updated regularly on your child's progress in school.

English and Maths

It is the intention here at Lodge Farm, when teaching the English and Maths curriculum that our pupils acquire the necessary knowledge, skills and understanding to become lifelong learners and linguists. We strive to ensure that all our pupils receive a well-rounded learning experience when reading, writing, speaking and listening which will equip them with the fundamental tools to achieve in school and beyond. It is our intention to immerse pupils in the wonders of quality texts to instil a love for reading, a passion for discovery, and a confidence and understanding to apply their learning in their everyday experiences.

Wider Curriculum

We teach a broad and balanced curriculum through a range of foundation subjects including humanities, DT and cooking, creative and performing arts, IT, PE and RE. Pupils in KS2 have weekly swimming lessons and have opportunities to learn a variety of musical instruments. We pride ourselves on the experiences we give our pupils including visits to London, Birmingham and the seaside alongside educational visits to the zoo, places of worship, theatres, museums and residential weeks.









Special Educational Needs

Vision

Lodge Farm Primary School adopts a 'whole school approach' to special educational needs. All staff work to ensure inclusion of all pupils. The school is committed to ensuring that pupils with special educational needs can fulfil their potential and achieve optimal educational outcomes.

Mission Statement for our children with Special Educational Needs (SEN)

- ENTHUSIASM: Be enthusiastic, independent, life-long learners who achieve their full potential.
- SELF WORTH develop a strong sense of selfworth and mutual respect, be able to lead safe, healthy and fulfilling lives.
- **LEARNING:** Enjoy learning and believe they can make a positive difference.
- SUCCESS: Nurture self-esteem and enjoy celebrating their successes.
- INCLUSION: Treat everyone fairly and with respect in an inclusive environment.

We will:

- Involve you in supporting your child's learning.
- Keep you informed about the support your child is receiving.
- Involve you in reviewing your child's progress.
- Liaise with the outside agencies who may come into school to help support your child's learning e.g. Speech and Language Therapy, Educational Psychology etc.
- Update the school's SEND register (a system for ensuring all the SEND pupils in this school are known) and make sure that there are excellent records of your child's progress and needs.
- Provide specialist support for teachers and support staff in the school so they can help children with SEND to achieve their best possible outcomes.



For your child this would mean:

- The teacher has the highest possible expectations. All teaching is based upon what your child already knows and can do.
 For example, practical activities and visual supports are in place so that your child is fully involved in learning in class.
- Specific strategies (which may be suggested by the SENCO or outside agencies) are in place to support children to learn. Progress is formally assessed and recorded three times throughout the year. Targets are set for your child to ensure that gaps in their

understanding and learning are addressed. Some additional individual or small group support may take place, either in the classroom during class time, or outside of whole class learning.
