



EYFS Topic: Superheroes

Year: Nur Term: Summer 2

Key Knowledge/Content:

- Participate in small group, class and one-to-• one discussions, offering their own ideas, using recently introduced vocabulary.
- Negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others.
- Explain the reasons for rules, know right from wrong and try to behave accordingly.
