Good afternoon parents,

It is with great pleasure that I can now inform you of the results of our recent Ofsted Inspection which took place on 27th and 28th February.

The inspector that visited our school carried out their inspection over the two days, which included deep dives into various subjects, lesson visits, discussions with staff/pupils, meetings with school leaders and scrutiny of work undertaken by children. They met with myself as head teacher, Senior Leadership Team, members of the governing body, CEO, spoke with parents, and reviewed documentation provided by the school. More of what the inspector looked at can be viewed in the report.

The inspector concluded that Lodge Farm Primary School remains GOOD in all areas (Quality of Education, Behaviour and Attitudes, Personal Development and Leadership and Management), resulting in a judgement that the school remains a **GOOD** school.

It was stated that "Lodge Farm Primary is a community of happy pupils and adults. The school actively promotes and celebrates aspiration and diversity" and "The school achieves its aim for all pupils, including those with special needs and/ or disabilities (SEND), to be become positive, confident and ambitious learners."

This is an excellent achievement for the School and I am exceptionally proud of all staff and pupils for their efforts during this inspection, the time leading up to the inspection, and the ongoing performance of the school. I am especially proud of the pupils, as quoted in the report "Behaviour is good in lessons and at other times of the day, including break times. Lessons are engaging and pupils want to learn. They are polite and well mannered."

There are many statements that reflect the positive work that underpin the good outcomes for the children and families of Lodge Farm Primary, but I think the one statement in the report that encapsulates this was said by a pupil to the inspector "It's like home, we are all friends: we care about each other."













It is worth recognising that the report is extremely positive, and although there was one area highlighted for improvement, school leaders had already identified (and have been working to improve) this area. This clearly demonstrates the strong leadership of the school, who are committed to implement and review strategies which will deal with the areas raised by the Ofsted inspection.
