



PSHE Topic: What can we do with money?

Year: 1 Term: Spring 1

Key Knowledge/Content:

• **Economic wellbeing:** Money- Learn what form money comes in particularly when digital. They will also discuss the different choices that people make about how they spend their money. They will discuss in detail the difference between when we need something and when we want something. Key vocabulary with definition: Prior vocabulary:

- Career/job- an occupation undertaken for a significant period of a person's life and with opportunities for progress.
- Coins- Type of money.

New vocabulary:

- Priority- The fact or condition of being regarded or treated as more important than others.
- Substitute- A person or thing acting or serving in place of another.
