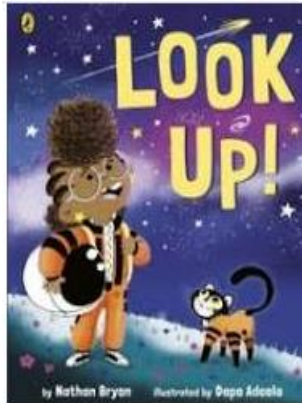


# Lodge Farm Primary School

## Year 1 Term: Summer 1

### English



#### Key Content:

This half term, our class reading book is *Look Up! By Nathan Bryan*. Children will write a range of genres: fantasy narrative, diary recount and poetry. They will also be listening to, discussing and reciting the poem: *Queue for the Zoo* by Clare Bevan.

Children will be taught Phonics every morning following the Little Wandle Letters and Sound programme. Our phonics sessions will focus on learning sounds, blending for reading and segmenting for spelling. Children will continue to focus on developing three reading skills:

- Decoding
- Prosody: teaching children to read with understanding and expression
- Comprehension: teaching children to understand the text.

Please continue to practice their phonics at home as much as possible.

Five children share some grapes.

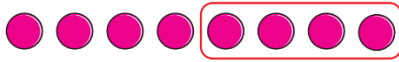
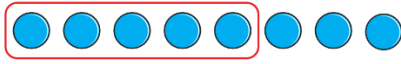


a) Draw lines to share the grapes equally.

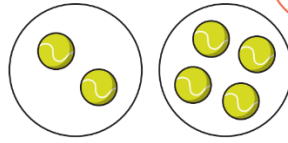
#### **Number – Fractions**

There are two groups, so each one is half.



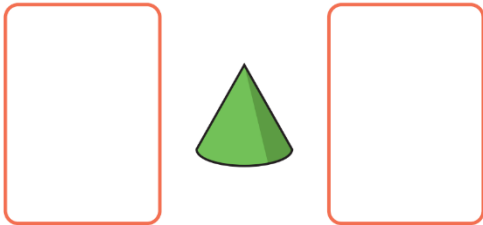

- Draw a triangle to the right of the cone.

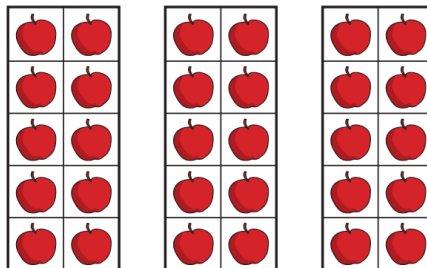
### Number – Place Value within 100
