Art and Design Topic: Claire Willberg

Year: 3 Term: Spring 2

Key Knowledge/Content:

- To know a famous artist is well known and creates pieces of art.
- Collage is a technique of creating artwork by attaching different materials, such as paper and fabric, to a canvas or paper.
- That shapes have both a positive and negative element.
- That we can arrange shapes to create exciting compositions.
- That we can build up imagery through layering shapes.

Links to:

Prior learning:

The children explored Hannah Hoch's designs and discussed her artwork. Children made a collage using inspiration from Hoch's work. All children evaluated their work and compare to the original artist.

Future learning:

The children are going to be learning about a famous artist called Jasper John.

Key vocabulary with definition:

Prior vocabulary:

- Shade To add slight darkness.
- Tone How light or dark something is based off colour.
- Detail To add specific features you can see.
- Texture the perceived surface quality of a work of art (see, touch or both).
- Material What things are made from.

New vocabulary:

- Combine To join something together.
- Background The part of a picture, scene, or design that forms a setting for the main figures or objects, or appears furthest from the viewer.
- Foreground The part of a view that is nearest to the observer, especially in a picture or photograph.
- Collage A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.
- Layer Putting a variety of materials and textures on top of each other.

By the end of this unit

All children can: identify a range of materials used and explain their own collage.

Most children can: demonstrate how to add layers to a collage and **explain** the effect of what layering does to a piece of art.

Some children can: demonstrate and **explain** how Willberg's work influenced them in their own work and explain what they like, dislike in her work.

Background understanding for teachers and parents:

The children are going to be learning about an artist called Claire Willberg. Willberg focuses on collages. The children will explore a range of materials to create their own collages using inspiration from Willberg's work.
