Year 3 Term: Autumn 2

English

Key Content:

This half term, our class reading book is 'Charlotte's Web' By E.B.White.

Children will explore a range of writing genres (non-chronological reports, explanations and fantasy narratives) linked to their class reading book. They will plan, write, proof read, edit and produce a final 'best' version for each genre. Children will also be listening to, discussing, reciting and writing their own version of the poem: 'Sound Collector' By Roger Gough.



Reading lessons will be linked to their class reading book and will focus on:

- Meaning of words in context.
- How information is related and contributes to meaning as a whole.
- How meaning is enhanced through choice of words and phrases.
- Retrieve and record information.
- Make comparisons within the text.

Spellings

Children will bring home 10 spellings every week and will be tested every Friday. Please ensure that they practise their spellings throughout the week using the Spelling Shed website in preparation for their spelling test.

- Divide by 4
- The 4 times-table
- Multiply by 8
- Divide by 8
- The 8 times-table
- The 2, 4 and 8 times-tables

Times Tables Rock Stars is a carefully sequenced programme of daily times tables practice. Children should be logging on weekly at home to practice their times table recall.
