Year 3 Term: Summer 1

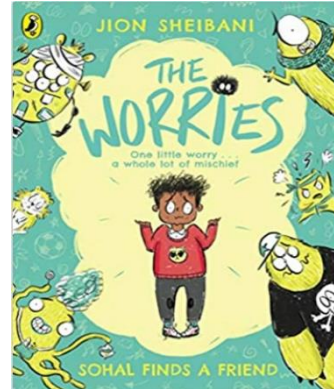
English

Key Content:

This half term, our class reading book is *The Worries* by Jion Sheibani and our class poem is *The Adventures of Isabel* by Ogden Nash

Children will explore a range of writing genres (stories with dilemma, recounts and poetry) linked to their class reading book. They will plan, write, proof read, edit and produce a final 'best' version for each genre.

When exploring poetry, children will explore the structure, vocabulary choices and describe the effect on the reader. Children will write their own simile poem and then perform their poem, reading clearly and with expression.



Reading lessons will be linked to their class reading book and will focus on:

- Making comparisons.
- Explaining how meaning is enhanced through the choice of words.
- Making inferences from the text.

Children will bring home 10 spellings every week and will be tested every Friday. Please ensure that they practise their spellings throughout the week using the Spelling Shed website in preparation for their spelling test.

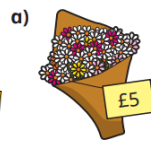

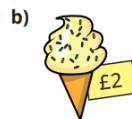

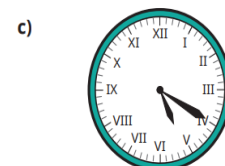
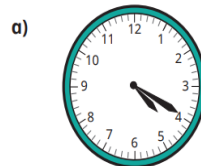
Measurement – Time
