



**French Topic:** Les fruits (Fruits)

**Year:** 3 **Term:** Spring 2

## Key Knowledge/Content:

- Name, recognise and remember up to 10 fruits in French.
- Spell some of these nouns with their correct article/determiner.
- Ask somebody in French if they like a particular fruit.
- Say what fruits we like and dislike in French
- Phonics Focus: CH OU ON

## Links to:

### Prior learning:

To know what a noun and article/determiner is and what a verb is in English and use vocabulary from the 'J'apprends le français' unit.

### Future learning:

To understand better that nouns in French are either masculine or feminine in the context of ice cream flavours and understand different words for 'a/an' in French depending on the gender of the noun.

## By the end of this unit

**All children can:** Name and spell some fruits (using the correct article) in French with accurate pronunciation.

**Most children can:** Can say in French which of the ten fruits I like and dislike.

**Some children can:** Can clearly understand the language required to ask a question in French regarding their opinion of a fruit and also understand how to answer the question in French, using the positive and negative form.

## Background understanding for teachers and parents:

This unit will be focused on the children recognising and spelling ten fruits in the French language. The children will also be learning how to ask a question (Do you like a particular fruit?) and answer it in French including a simple opinion (I like..., I do not like...).
