Key Knowledge/Content:

- To learn how to ask and answer the question 'As-tu des frères et sœurs? (Do you have any brothers or sisters?)'
- To consolidate numbers 1-10 and to introduce numbers 1-70 in French.

Prior learning:

Use basic decoding skills to help deal with longer text that will contain much unfamiliar language.

Future learning:

Continue to attempt and write longer more interesting sentences including the correct nouns and conjunctions.
