# Key Knowledge/Content:

- Health and wellbeing- Ourselves, growing and changing: Children will talk about the physical and emotional changes that happen when approaching and during puberty.
- Children will discuss hygiene routines and the importance of keeping clean, including how to maintain personal hygiene.
