### English

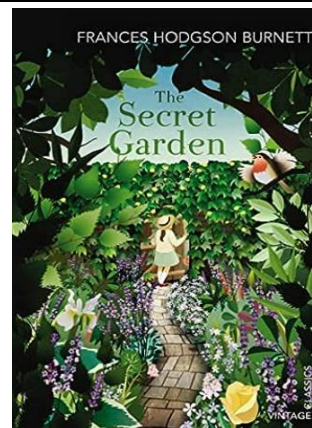
#### Key Content:

This half term, our class reading book is *'The Secret Garden'* By Frances Hodgson Burnett.

Children will explore a range of writing genres (historical narrative, balanced argument and poetry) linked to their class reading book. They will plan, write, proof read, edit and produce a final 'best' version for each genre. When exploring poetry, children will be listening to, discussing, reciting and writing their own version of the poem: *'Leisure'* By W. H. Davies.

Reading lessons will be linked to their class reading book and will focus on:

- Meaning of words in context.
- How information is related and contributes to meaning as a whole.
- How meaning is enhanced through choice of words and phrases.
- Retrieve and record information.
- Make comparisons within the text.



#### Spellings

Children will bring home 10 spellings every week and will be tested every Friday. Please ensure that they practise their spellings throughout the week using the Spelling Shed website in preparation for their spelling test.

#### BoomReader

Please help your child by ensuring that they read for at least 15 minutes each night and use the BoomReader app to log pages read at home.

This half term the class will be looking at:

#### Fractions

- Find fractions equivalent to a unit fraction
- Find fractions equivalent to a non-unit fraction
- Recognise equivalent fractions
- Convert improper fractions to mixed numbers
- Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions
- Compare fractions less than 1
- Order fractions less than 1
- Compare and order fractions greater than 1
- Add fractions within 1
- Add fractions with total greater than 1
- Add to a mixed number
- Add two mixed numbers
- Subtract fractions
- Subtract from a mixed number
- Subtract from a mixed number – breaking the whole
