Year 6 Term: Summer 2

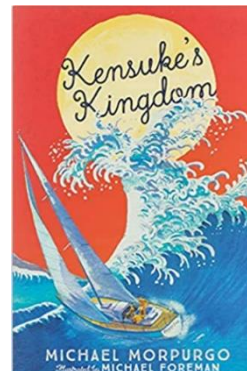
English

Key Content:

This half term, our class reading book is *Kensuke's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo.

Children will explore a range of writing genres: stories from other cultures persuasion, instructions and poetry. They will plan, write, proof read, edit and produce a final 'best' version for each genre.

Our class poem is *The River* by Valerie Bloom. Children will explore the structure (rhyme scheme and rhythm), vocabulary choices, tone, mood and use of poetic devices including onomatopoeia, personification and metaphors. They will then rehearse and perform *The River* using clear expression and intonation. Children will also write and perform their own cinquain poem based on the river.



Spellings

Children will bring home 10 spellings every week and will be tested every Friday. Please ensure that they practise their spellings throughout the week using the Spelling Shed website in preparation for their spelling test.

BoomReader

Please help your child by ensuring that they read for at least 15 minutes each night and use the BoomReader app to log this information. In Year 6, they may read independently some evenings, however they should be listened to by an adult.
