Key Knowledge/Content:

New vocabulary:

- Je = I
- Tu = You
- Il = He
- Elle = She
- Nous = We
- Vous = You all
- Ils = They (masculine)
- Elles = They (feminine)
- Using the regular -ER verb jouer ('to play')
- Using the regular -IR verb finir ('to finish')
- Using the regular -RE verb vendre ('to sell')

By the end of this unit

All children can: recall previously learnt language and **incorporate** it with new language learnt in this topic.

Most children can: recall the three different types of infinitive verb categories in French. –ER, –IR, –RE.

Some children can: write sentences in French using regular verbs.

Background understanding for teachers and parents:
