English

Key Content:

This half term, our class reading books are *'Paddington at the Palace'* by Michael Bond and *'Katie in London'* by James Mayhew.

Children will use their knowledge of these stories to write a range of genres: short adventure story, diary recount and letters. They will also be listening to, discussing and reciting the poem: *'Water'* by Shirley Hughes

Phonics

Children will be taught Phonics every morning following the Little Wandle Letters and Sound programme. Our phonics sessions will focus on learning sounds, blending for reading and segmenting for spelling. Children will focus on developing three reading skills:

- Decoding.
- prosody: teaching children to read with understanding and expression.
- comprehension: teaching children to understand the text.


Please continue to practice their phonics at home as much as possible.
