
## Year 2 Term: Autumn 2

### English

#### Key Content:


This half term, our class reading book is *The Elves and the Shoemaker* by Vera Southgate and *The Town Mouse and the Country Mouse* retold by Susanna Davidson and Jacqueline East.

Children will write a range of genres: fable narrative, letters and traditional narratives. They will plan, write, proof read, edit and produce a final 'best' version for each genre. Children will also be listening to, discussing and reciting the poem: *'Daddy Fell Into the Pond'* by Alfred Noyes.



Reading lessons will be linked to their class reading book and will focus on:

- Retrieve and record information.
- Sequence of events.
- Knowledge of vocabulary.
- Prediction.
- Inference.
