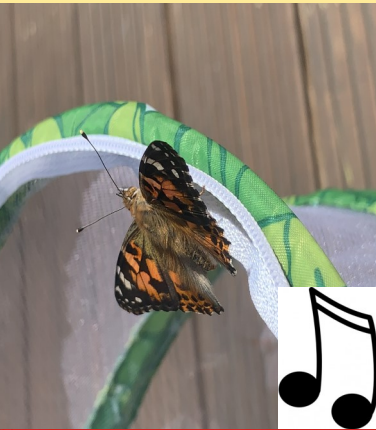


# Lodge Farm June/July Newsletter
